The Next Meeting - Jan. 18, 2017 - 6:30pm at Concordia Senior High School

Dr. Esperanca Camara, Associate Professor of Art History at St. Francis, will discuss the Salon des Refuses (or Salon of the Rejected). The famous Salon de Refuses of 1863 was the first gathering of Impressionist artists. The works were rejected by the official Paris Salon. So, too, there may be some great works among those rejected by the Venture judges. We will hold our own Salon des Refuses from prior Venture exhibits at the February meeting. More details to follow.

Monthly Challenge - PAINTING SNOW

The January monthly challenge will be your opportunity to exhibit a painting of SNOW utilizing the tips and techniques from Doug Runyan's excellent presentation. In case you missed it, snow has color! It is not painting with a mixture of greys and white or light blues, but many colors. Bright areas of snow are painted with a warm white, (white with a touch of yellow) Shadows are important to describe shapes of snow as well as values and color. During the next snow storm, don't complain - PAINT.
