6:30 p.m., January 18, 2017

43 were present, including 3 guests and 3 new members. John Kelty called the meeting to order, then turned the time to Linda Binek to introduce Esperanca Camara, PhD.. She presented the history and reasons for the formation of the Salon des Refuses. Excellent! A copy of the power point will be available through Linda Binek.

BUSINESS: President John Kelty called the business meeting to order at 7:43 p.m.

Minutes were accepted as printed in December 2016 Fine Lines.

Treasurer's Report was accepted as printed in December 2016 Fine Lines.

Membership Linda Hall gave a total membership of 88. We welcomed new members Dave Broerman, Patricia Weiss, and Lynn Padget.

Ventures Judy Zehner announced the judge is Carolyn Lewis (member of Oil Painters of America), from the Cleveland area. She will hold a two-day workshop for up to 12. Member cost for workshop is \$200, and \$250 for non-members.

Exhibitions Nancy Longmate said there are 4 or 5 places available in March/April, and more openings in the months after that.

Publicity Susan Wenger showed us a copy of the newspaper with the list of those exhibiting. She sends that information in by the 15th each month, and sends in publicity for our member meetings two weeks in advance.

Programs Linda Binek said February will be a demo from John Kelty, completing a watercolor painting in one hour. March is Nazar Harran, an abstract demo. April is still in progress, but hoping for Jenna, who judged the member show at Aldersgate, to tell us what judges look for. February member challenge is to bring your Salon de Refuse (such as not accepted by a prior Ventures Show). March member challenge is to bring in art work completed in two hours or less. April meeting will be April 12 instead of April 19 because of conflict with the IPAPA workshop in New Harmony.

Newsletter Terri said New Harmony information was in the last newsletter. She wants to know of our accomplishments and any other art news to put in the newsletter.

Old Business 1) We have a new mic and speakers for programs and other FWAG use. 2) ACPL Member Show will be Feb 20-April 7. Apply by Feb 6. \$5 fee (will cover refreshments at open house on February 24 (6:30-8:30). Drop off is February 13. Info is in the newsletter and web site. No commission required, so artist receives the full price of sold works. The library is willing to host this every other year.

New Business 1) Esperanca Camara donated her gratuity to the Marsha Patterson award fund.



Eligibility: Artists must be members of Fort Wayne Artists Guild with a paid 2017 membership. We will be taking new memberships the day of drop-off.

Medium: All painting and drawing medium, sculpture, fabric and ceramics. No photography and no reproductions or giclees.

Entry Procedure: All works will be accepted, this is not a juried show. No size limitation on work. All work must be original, conceived and created by artist. All 2D work must be framed and wired for hanging. All artists are allowed to enter 3 pieces. Any work produced within the last 3 years is eligible. All works not priced for sale will be listed as NFS. No commission will be charged. Artist's name needs to be on back of each piece. Artists will be required to sign a liability release for ACPL at drop-off. Fill out entry form at bottom of this sheet and mail in.

Entry Fee: Entry fee will be \$5.00 for up to 3 pieces.

Drop-offs: Work can be dropped off at the downtown Allen County Public Library Gallery,
Mon., Feb.13th, 9:00am-1:00pm and 5:00-7:00pm

Show Opening: Mon., Feb. 20, 2017

Opening Reception: Friday, February 24th, 6:30-8:30pm, Jefferey R. Krull Gallery, Downtown Library.

Pick-up: Artwork can be picked up Sat. April 1, 2017, 11-3pm

Gallery Hours: The gallery will be open during regular library hours. Mon.-Thurs. 9:00am-9:00pm, Fri. and Sat. 9:00am-6:00pm and Sun.12:00-5:00pm.
